PUBLIC PLACE NAMES ACT 1989

DETERMINATION NO 5 OF 1991

**EXPLANATORY STATEMENT**

The Public Place Names Act 1989 provides for the naming of divisions and public places and, in particular, section 4 empowers the Minister, by notice published in the Gazette, to determine the name of a division or public place.

Pursuant to section 5 of the Administration Act 1989 the Chief Minister has delegated the power under the Public Place Names Act 1989 to name a division or public place to the person for the time being holding or performing the duties of the Office of Senior Executive Band 2 Position Number 5244, Land Division, Department of the Environment Land and Planning.

Schedule "A" of the Determination, together with the accompanying maps, details the name, origin and significance of the division of Palmerston, the first division to be named in the new town of Gungahlin.
