# **ROAD TRANSPORT (OFFENCES) REGULATIONS 2001**

### SUBORDINATE LAW No. 20 OF 2001

## **EXPLANATORY STATEMENT**

#### Overview

The Road Transport (Offences) Regulations 2000 are repealed and replaced with the Road Transport (Offences) Regulations 2001. The new Regulations increase infringement notice penalties for some traffic offences to maintain parity with NSW penalties for similar offences.

Some 'housekeeping' amendments simplify regulations 8, 17 and 21 of the *Road Transport (Offences) Regulations 2000*.

#### Detail

- 1. Regulation 8 is reworded to remove the repetitive use of some words in subparagraphs (a) to (h).
- 2. Subregulation 17 (2) has been split and more appropriately located at subregulations 18 (1) and 19 (1).
- 3. Subregulations 17 (3) and 17 (4) have been recast as new regulation 17 (2) to add clarity to the application of demerit points during holiday periods.
- 4. Subregulation 21 (2) has been remade as regulation 21 (1) (f) to add clarity to the meaning of holiday periods.
- 5. In the table following, where an existing infringement penalty amount is listed in Column 1, the new infringement penalty is listed in Column 2. An example only of an offence to which the penalty amount applies is provided in Column 1.
