## **LIQUOR REGULATIONS AMENDMENT**

This Regulation amends the Liquor Regulations, restricting the sale of beer in glass bottles between 12 noon and 11 pm on 31 December 2000, with the intention of reducing the potential for injury resulting from broken glass during the New Year celebration.

### **Notes on Clauses**

#### **Clause 1 Commencement**

The amendments will commence on the commencement of section 2 of the *Liquor Amendment Act 2000*.

#### **Clause 2 Regulations amended –**

The regulations amend the Liquor Regulations.

#### **Clause 3 Definition**

This clause defines beer for the purposes of the regulation.

#### **Clause 4 Insertion**

Sections 45, 47, 48 and 49 of the Liquor Act permit the making of regulations that restrict the sale of alcohol, by type of container for a specified period. This clause prohibits the holders of liquor licences that permit the sale of liquor for off premises consumption referred to in sections 45, 47, 48 and 49 of the Act from selling beer in glass bottles between 12 noon and 11 pm on 31 December 2000.
