MOTOR TRAFFIC (ALCOHOL AND DRUGS) REGULATIONS (AMENDMENT)

Explanatory Memorandum

The Motor Traffic (Alcohol and Drugs) Regulations (Amendment) ("the amending Regulation") amends the Motor Traffic (Alcohol and Drugs) Regulations ("the Regulations") which support the *Motor Traffic (Alcohol and Drugs) Act 1977* ("the Act").

Regulation 1 of the amending Regulation is a formal provision relating to the interpretation of a term used in the amending Regulation.

Regulations 2, 3 and 4 of the amending Regulation are consequential upon an amendment to the Act made by the *Motor Traffic (Alcohol and Drugs) (Amendment) Act 1992* to change the references in the Act to a "breath analysing instrument" to references to a "breath analysis instrument".

Regulation 5 of the amending Regulation removes sexist terms in the Regulations and replaces them with gender neutral language.
