#### AMENDMENT OF THE SUPREME COURT RULES

The amendments to the Supreme Court Rules effected by these rules are as follows:

### Rule 2: Order 34A Rule 2:

The amendments to Order 34A Rule 2 correct an error in which a reference in paragraph (c) of the rule is made to rule 9 which does not exist. Paragraph (c) is, therefore, omitted.

# Rule 3: Order 42 Rule 14:

The amendment to Order 42 Rule 14 is consequential upon the insertion of new Part 5A of the Rules.

# Rule 4: Part 5A: Foreign Judgments:

New Part 5A of the Rules provide the procedure to be followed by a judgment creditor for the registration of a judgment to which Part 2 of the Foreign Judgments Act 1991 of the Commonwealth (reciprocal enforcement of judgments) applies. Part 5A is based substantially on the Federal Court Rules to ensure, so far as is possible, uniformity of procedure in this area.

## Rule 5: First and Second Schedules

The amendments to the First Schedule are consequential upon the insertion of new Part 5A of the Rules and correct errors in Form 72. The amendments to the Second Schedule are consequential upon the insertion of new Part 5A of the Rules.
