EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

Background

These Regulations are made pursuant to section 28 of the Workers' Compensation Act 1951.

Detail

Clause 1 provides for the commencement of the Regulation.

Clause 2 defines "Principal Regulations" to mean the "Workers' Compensation Regulations".

Clause 3 inserts new Regulations into the Principal Regulations.

Regulation 14 defines the cost of conveyance for the purposes of paragraph 11(3A)(b) of the Principal Act.

Regulation 15 defines the cost of accommodation for the purposes of paragraph 11(3A)(c) of the Principal Act.

Regulation 16 describes prescribed offences and fines for the purposes of Part VIB of the Principal Act.

Clause 4 amends the definition of anthrax in Schedule 2 of the Principal Regulations to specifically provide for anthrax contracted through the loading, unloading and transport of animals and merchandise.

Clause 5 amends the Principal Regulations by adding at end of Schedule 3 a table outlining the penalty units (on-the-spot-fines) for offences against specific subsections of the Act.
