WEAPONS REGULATIONS (AMENDMENT) No. OF 1996

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

Section 102 of the Weapons Act 1991 provides that the Executive may make regulations for the purposes of the Act. Part (c) of the definition of a prohibited weapon contained in Section 4 of the principal Act allows the Executive to add to the list of prohibited weapons contained in schedule 3 of the Act by regulation.

This amendment has the effect of including the product known as the *"Darchery Dartslinger"* and any similar device in the Schedule of prohibited weapons.

The "Darchery Dartslinger" is a device comprising a sliding carriage fitted to a barrel and attached to a trigger by means of rubber bands. It is designed to expel a dart from the sliding carriage by activating the trigger.

This regulation has no financial implications and will commence on gazettal.
