LAND (PLANNING AND ENVIRONMENT) REGULATIONS (AMENDMENT)

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

Section 282D of the Land (Planning and Environment) Act 1991 (the Land Act) specifies that a member of the Land and Planning Appeals Board (the Board) appointed under the Land Act shall be paid such remuneration and allowances as are prescribed by regulation. The Land Act also provides that where there is in existence a subsisting determination of the Commonwealth Remuneration Tribunal then that determination shall apply. There is, however, no subsisting determination.

The Land (Planning and Environment) Regulations (Amendment) (the Amending Regulation) amends the Land (Planning and Environment) Regulations by inserting a regulation that specifies the rate a member of the Board will be paid.

The Amending Regulation specifies the rate at which a member of the Board will be paid and has no revenue or cost implications.

Regulations 1 and 2

Regulations 1 and 2 of the Amending Regulation deal with machinery matters.

Regulation 1 specifies the title of the Regulation that is being amended, and Regulation 2 outlines the procedure for commencing the Amending Regulation.

Regulation 3

Regulation 3 will insert a new regulation (Regulation 23) that will specify that the Chairperson, or a member acting as Chairperson, of the Board shall be paid a daily rate of \$253 and a member shall be paid a daily rate of \$205.
