TRANS-TASMAN MUTUAL RECOGNITION BILL 1997

Outline

The purpose of the amendment is to provide that the ACT Legislative Assembly will be advised when the Chief Minister fixes a date for expiry of the Act, approves an amendment to the Commonwealth Act or endorses any change to the schedules to the Commonwealth Act.

Specific Clause

The amendment proposes to insert a new Clause 6A which will require the Chief Minister to lay before the Assembly any notices made under Clauses 3 or 6 of the draft Bill or any documents endorsing regulations to be made under subsections 44 (4), 45 (5), 47 (7), 48 (5) or 49 (3) of the Commonwealth Act.
