EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The *Public Place Names Act 1989* provides for the naming of divisions and public places and, in particular, section 4 empowers the Minister to determine in writing, published in the ACT Legislation Register, the name of a division or public place.

Pursuant to section 5 of the Administration Act 1989, the Minister has delegated the power under the Public Place Names Act 1989 to name a division or public place to the Chief Planning Executive, ACT Planning and Land Authority.

This Instrument determines the names of the public places at Lake Ginninderra in the Suburb of Belconnen as specified in the attached schedule and associated plan.

The number of women and men after whom divisions or public places have been named in the last 10 years, and whether the names of women are well-represented, have been considered as required by the *Public Place Names Act 1989*.

This instrument commemorates words from the Ngunnawal language.
