Amendments to be moved by the Attorney-General

Clause 4: Application

Clause 4 of the Bill is intended to preserve the pre-amendment Board structure and procedures for matters that the Board will have already commenced to hear at the time that the relevant amendments to the Act come into operation.

Clause 4 of the Bill refers to the incorrect sections and should refer to section 9 on page 2, line 7 and sections 8, 9 and 10 on page 2, line 9.
