EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

Section 34 of the *Liquor Act 1975* (the Act) provides that, with the Minister’s written approval, the Liquor Licensing Board may, in writing, amend or repeal the licensing standards manual (the manual). That approval was given on 9 September 2004.

The board has decided to amend paragraph 44 of the manual to provide that licensees shall not in licensed premises encourage excessive or rapid consumption of alcohol by “alcoholic vapour” produced by devices like the Alcohol Without Liquid (AWOL) device.
