

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

**Australian Capital Territory
Administrative Appeals Tribunal Regulations**

1989 No. 10

The Administrative Appeals Tribunal Regulations (the Regulations) are made under the Administrative Appeals Tribunal Ordinance 1989 (the Ordinance).

Regulation 1 provides that the Regulations be cited as the Administrative Appeals Tribunal Regulations.

Regulation 2 deals with matters of interpretation.

Regulation 3 deals with the design, custody and affixing of the Seal of the Tribunal.

Regulations 4 to 8 (inclusive) deal with the forms to be used for the purposes of sections 27, 28, 37 and 41 of the Act.

Regulation 9 requires the Registrar to give notice of requests to suspend or vary the operation of a decision to the parties to a proceeding.

Regulation 10 deals with the lodging and filing of documents with the Registrar.

Regulation 11 deals with notices under subsection 19(3) of the Act regarding the composition of the Tribunal.

Regulation 12 prescribes the number of copies of documents to be lodged with the Tribunal under subsection 37(1) of the Act.

Regulation 13 deals the form of a summons served under section 40 of the Act and the method of service.

Regulation 14 deals with the hours that the Tribunal Registry is open for business.

Regulation 15 provides for the remuneration and allowances of certain part-time members.
