EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

Overview

Section 96 of the Road Transport (General) Act 1999 allows for the determining of fees payable for refund and dishonour cheque payments made under the *Road Transport (General) Act 1999*. This instrument revokes Instrument No. 130 of 2004, notified in Gazette No. S6 on 28 June 2004.

Details

This instrument has the effect of determining fees under the *Road Transport* (*General*) *Act 1999* for transactions relating to refunds and the handling of dishonoured cheque payments.

The fee amounts specified for items 1,2 and 4 in schedule 1 remain unchanged. Item 3 has been included to reflect that refund fees may be charged for public passenger service accreditations, leased hire car licences and restricted taxi licences surrendered to the Road Transport Authority.
