Race and Sports Bookmaking (Sports Bookmaking Venues) Determination 2002 (No 3)

Disallowable instrument DI2002— 69

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The *Race and Sports Bookmaking Act 2001* (the Act) governs the activities of sports bookmakers in the Australian Capital Territory.

Part 3 of the Act provides for the conduct and control of sports bookmaking. In particular, section 21(1) of the Act provides that the Commission may determine a place to be a sports bookmaking venue for the purpose of the Act.

This determination approves the areas within a 1 metre radius of any selling terminal, owned and operated by ACTTAB Limited and located within the places identified in the attached schedule. A selling terminal is defined as a SELPOS or AMTOTE AT 1000 selling terminal.

This instrument revokes and replaces Determination DI2001-321 notified 9 October 2001. In particular, it provides for the approval of ACTTAB Ltd's new sub-agency at the Coolabah Club, 6 Georgina Crescent, Kaleen.
