## **EXPLANATORY STATEMENT**

# **Magistrates Court (Litter Infringement Notices) Amendment Regulation 2005 (No 1)**

## Overview

This regulation amends the Magistrates Court (Litter Infringement Notices) Regulation 2004 to expand the class of persons who may issue infringement notices for certain offences under the *Litter Act 2004* to include police officers.

## Background

The Magistrates Court (Litter Infringement Notices) Regulation enables infringement notices to be issued for certain offences against the *Litter Act 2004*.

## Section Notes

**Section 1 - Name of regulations** - provides that the name of the regulation is the *Magistrates Court (Litter Infringement Notices) Amendment Regulation 2005 No 1*).

**Section 2 - Commencement** - provides that the regulation commences on the day after its notification day.

**Section 3 – Legislation amended** – provides that the regulation amends the *Magistrates Court (Litter Infringement Notices) Regulation 2004*.

**Section 4 – Sections 10 and 11** – makes consequential amendments to sections 10 and 11 to provide that an infringement notice or reminder notice served by a police officer must identify the police officer by the service number for the police officer. This section also substitutes a new heading which reflects the changes made to the section.

**Section 5 – Service of notices by authorised people** – expands the class of persons who may issue infringement notices under the regulation to include police officers.
