Race and Sports Bookmaking (Sports Bookmaking Venues) Determination 2005 (No 2)

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The Race and Sports Bookmaking Act 2001 (the Act) regulates the activities of sports bookmakers in the Australian Capital Territory.

Part 3 of the Act provides for the conduct and control of sports bookmaking. Section 21(1) of the Act provides that the Commission may determine a place to be a sports bookmaking venue for the purpose of the Act.

This determination approves a specific part of Level 1 of the area known as "Acton Grandstand" located at the Canberra Racing Club, Thoroughbred Park, Randwick Road Lyneham ACT 2602, (Block 2, Section 69, Division of Lyneham), as identified by the shaded area on the plan attached to the determination, as a sports bookmaking venue for the purposes of the Act.
