***Children and Young People Act 1999*, Chapter 14 Standards and Standing Orders, section 403 (A) (Standing Orders – provisions about security)**

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

Section 403A of the *Children and Young People Act 1999* enables the Minister to certify that a Standing Order or a stated provision of the Standing Order applies to the security of a place of detention and the safety of people at a place of detention, and that its publication would be contrary to the public interest.

The Minister for Children, Youth and Family Support has made such a certification in relation to the Standing Orders made under DI2005-167.

The Standing Orders to which this certification applies at Quamby Youth Detention Centre include:

- Standing Order 8. Video Surveillance/Recording;
- Standing Order 12. Hospital Watch;
- Standing Order 14. Use of Force;
- Standing Order 15. Searches;
- Standing Order 17. Assaults;
- Standing Order 18. Escapes and Attempted Escapes;
- Standing Order 21. Emergency Situations;
- Standing Order 22. Escorts;
- Standing Order 23. Vehicle Checks and Maintenance; and
- Standing Order 26. Access and Physical Security.
