DISALLOWABLE INSTRUMENT: DI2005 - 187

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

This determination sets out the maximum fares for ACTION Authority regular route services. The instrument amends the definition of an exempt person to include any member of the public wearing service medals on the 14th and 15th of August 2005 to commemorate the 60th anniversary of the end of the Second World War.

The instrument also amends the definition of a Student to include a student who is registered for home schooling under the *Education Act 2004*.

The maximum fare amounts remain unchanged. The fares schedule table has been amended to make it clear that students are also eligible for all concession ticket types apart from the concession off-peak daily ticket.
