Road Transport (Offences) Holiday Period Declaration 2005

Disallowable instrument DI2005–268

Made under the

Road Transport (Offences) Regulation 2005, subsection 22(1)(e) Meaning of holiday period.

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The *Road Transport (Offences) Regulation 2005*, subsection 22(1)(e), provide for the Minister to declare a period to be a holiday period. The declaration, by virtue of subsection 22(4), is a disallowable instrument for the purposes of section 9 of the *Legislation Act 2001*.

This instrument specifies the period from the first moment of Friday 23 December 2005 to the last moment of Monday 2 January 2006 (inclusive) to be a holiday period. Accordingly, for this period, additional demerit points, as specified in subsection 20(2) of the Regulation, will apply.

The declaration will link the Christmas holiday period for December 2005 with the New Year holiday period for January 2006, which will be consistent with the double demerit period in NSW.

This declaration is a disallowable instrument, and must be presented to the Legislative Assembly within 6 sitting days after its notification in pursuance of section 64 of the *Legislation Act 2001*.
