Public Place Names (Several Divisions) Determination 2006 (No 1)

Disallowable instrument DI2006 - 25

made under the

Public Place Names Act 1989— section 3 (Minister to determine names)

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The *Public Place Names Act 1989* provides for the naming of divisions and public places and, in particular, section 3 empowers the Minister to determine in writing, published in the ACT Legislation Register, the name of a division or public place.

Pursuant to Part 254A of the *Legislation Act 2001*, the Minister has delegated the power under the *Public Place Names Act 1989* to name a division or public place to the Chief Planning Executive, ACT Planning and Land Authority.

Section 46 of the *Legislation Act 2001* specifies that power given under an Act to make an instrument includes the power to amend or repeal the instrument.

This Instrument:

DETERMINES the names of the public places that are Territory land described in the attached Schedule A and as indicated in the attached map.

REVOKES the name of the public place that is Territory land as described in the attached Schedule B;

VARIES the descriptions of the public places that are Territory land as described in the attached Schedule C.

This determination will be taken to have commenced on 19 July 1989.

Determinations Nos. 1 & 2 of 1989 notified in the Australian Capital Territory Gazette No. ACT 9 of 19 July 1989 was deferred in the Assembly's business on 27 July 1989, the Assembly failed to return to it. The instrument is deemed to be repealed. This subsequent determination rectifies that anomaly.
