DETERMINATION OF A PLACE TO BE A SPORTS BOOKMAKING VENUE

Outline

The *Race and Sports Bookmakers Act 2001* (the Act) governs the activities of sports bookmaking in the Australian Capital Territory.

Part 3 of the Act provides for the conduct and control of sports bookmaking. In particular, the legislation empowers the Commission to determine a place to be a sports bookmaking venue.

Section 21(1) of the Act provides that the Commission may determine a place to be a sports bookmaking venue for the purpose of the Act.

This instrument determines the same sports bookmaking venues approved pursuant to Determination No. 269 of 2001, notified in Gazette No S68 of 7 September 2001, except for a change to the location of the West Civic Agency.

This sports bookmaking venue determination relates to ACTTAB Limited agencies identified in the schedule attached to the determination.
