DETERMINATION OF FEES FOR BUS ACCREDITATION

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The object of the fee determination is to provide a regime of fees for the accreditation of people to operate bus services.

The fee for an application for bus accreditation is:

- \$200 for an application from an operator with five or less buses; or
- \$400 for an application from an operator with six or more buses.

A bus service operator accreditation attracts an annual fee comprising two parts:

- a fixed part of \$150 for operators with five or less buses or \$300 for operators with six or more buses; and
- a variable part calculated on the basis of \$55 for each bus used to operate the service, apart from the first bus.

The fee determination commences on the day of the commencement of the Road Transport (Public Passenger Services) Act 2001.
