Road Transport (Safety and Traffic Management) Parking Authority Declaration 2006 (No 2)

Disallowable instrument DI2006–78

made under the

Road Transport (Safety and Traffic Management) Regulation 2000, s 75A (2) (Parking Authority)

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

Section 75A (2) of the *Road Transport (Safety and Traffic Management) Regulation 2000* permits the Road Transport Authority to declare an organisation to be a Parking Authority which may establish and operate a ticket parking scheme for any length of road or area under its control in accordance with the Road Transport (Safety and Traffic Management) Guidelines 2002.

Calvary Health Care ACT has applied to the Road Transport Authority to be a Parking Authority for the following location:

- Block 1 of Section 1 in the suburb of Bruce.

The Disallowable Instrument effects the declaration by the Road Transport Authority of Calvary Health Care ACT as a Parking Authority for the car park areas identified.

This declaration is a Disallowable Instrument, and must be presented to the Legislative Assembly within 6 sitting days after its notification in pursuance of Section 64 of the *Legislation Act 2001*.
