Road Transport (General) Demand Responsive Services Fees Determination 2006 (No 1)

Disallowable instrument DI2006–126

made under the *Road Transport (General) Act 1999*, section 96 (Determination of fees, charges and other amounts)

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

Section 96 of the *Road Transport (General) Act 1999* allows for the determining of fees, charges and other amounts payable under the Road Transport Legislation. A determination under section 96 is a disallowable instrument.

The Determination provides for fees associated with the Road Transport (Public Passenger Services) amendment Regulation 2006 (No 1) about demand responsive services. The fees are for:

- applications for accreditation to provide a demand responsive service;
- applications for authorisation as a demand responsive service;
- accreditation to provide a demand responsive service; and
- replacement certificates of accreditation.

The fees set out in this determination applying to demand responsive services are consistent with the fees applying to bus services providing regular route services or tour and charter services.

This instrument commences on the day after notification.
