EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The *Nature Conservation Act 1980* provides for protection and conservation of native animals and native plants, and for the management of reserved areas.

Section 139 of the Act provides the Minister with the power to determine fees.

The purpose of this determination is to revoke Disallowable Instrument DI 2005—183 that set fees for the 2005-2006 financial year and to determine fees for the 2006-2007 financial year.

All fees have increased by the Wage Price Index (3.7%).

The fees take effect on 10 July 2006.

The determination under section 139 of the Act is a disallowable instrument.
