EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The *Animal Diseases Act 2005* is an Act to provide for the control of endemic and exotic diseases of animals, and for related purposes.

Section 88 of the Act provides the Minister with the power to determine fees.

This instrument sets the fees for the 2006 – 2007 financial year.

All fees have increased by the Wage Price Index (3.7%).

The fees take effect on 10 July 2006.

The determination under section 88 of the Act is a disallowable instrument.
