#### **INSTRUMENT NO. 206 OF 2002**

#### **EXPLANATORY STATEMENT**

The Road Transport (Offences) Regulations 2001, under subregulation 21(1)(e), empower the Minister to declare a period to be a holiday period. The notice, by virtue of subregulation 21(4), is a disallowable instrument for the purposes of section 9 of the *Legislation Act 2001*.

This instrument specifies the period from the first moment of Friday 20 December 2002 to the last moment of Wednesday 1 January 2003 (inclusive) to be a holiday period. Accordingly, for this period, additional demerit points, as specified in subregulation 20(2), will apply.

The declaration will link the Christmas holiday period for December 2002 with the New Year holiday period for January 2003, which will be consistent with the double demerit period in NSW.
