EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The *Heritage Act 2004* is an Act to provide for the protection of heritage, and for related purposes.

Section 120 of the Act provides the Minister with the power to determine fees. The purpose of this determination is to set fees from the date of effect until 30 June 2007.

Under the Schedule to this instrument, tailored searches of the register may include searches by ownership, type of place, theme or other factors.

This instrument takes effect on the day after notification on the Legislation Register.

The determination under section 120 of the Act is a disallowable instrument.
