# Road Transport (Safety and Traffic Management) Parking Authority Declaration 2007 (No 1)

Disallowable instrument DI2007–39

made under the

*Road Transport (Safety and Traffic Management) Regulation 2000, s 75A (2) (Parking Authority)*

## EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

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Section 75A (2) of the *Road Transport (Safety and Traffic Management) Regulation 2000* permits the Road Transport Authority to declare an organisation to be a Parking Authority which may establish and operate a ticket parking scheme for any length of road or area under its control in accordance with the Road Transport (Safety and Traffic Management) Guidelines 2002.

Westfield Shopping Centre Management Co. (A.C.T.) Pty Limited has applied to the Road Transport Authority to be a Parking Authority for the following locations that are owned by Westfield:

- Block 2, Section 64 in the suburb of Phillip; and
- Block 9, Section 17 in the suburb of Phillip.

The disallowable instrument effects the declaration by the Road Transport Authority of Westfield Shopping Centre Management Co. (A.C.T.) Pty Limited as a Parking Authority for the car park areas identified allowing Westfield to establish and operate a ticket parking scheme.

This disallowable instrument also revokes disallowable instrument number DI2002-149 that declared Lend Lease, the previous owner of Block 9, Section 17 of Philip, as a Parking Authority for that area.

This declaration is a Disallowable Instrument, and must be presented to the Legislative Assembly within 6 sitting days after its notification in pursuance of Section 64 of the *Legislation Act 2001*.
