Road Transport (Safety and Traffic Management) Parking Authority Declaration 2007 (No 2)

Disallowable instrument DI2007–296

made under the

Road Transport (Safety and Traffic Management) Regulation 2000, s 75A (2) (Parking Authority)

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

Section 75A (2) of the *Road Transport (Safety and Traffic Management) Regulation 2000* permits the Road Transport Authority to declare an organisation to be a Parking Authority which may establish and operate a ticket parking scheme for any length of road or area under its control in accordance with the Road Transport (Safety and Traffic Management) Guidelines 2002.

Ezipark Pty Ltd has applied to the Road Transport Authority to be a Parking Authority for the following location:

Block 19, Section 162 in the suburb of Phillip.

The disallowable instrument effects the declaration by the Road Transport Authority of Ezipark Pty Ltd as a Parking Authority for the car park areas identified allowing Ezipark Pty Ltd to establish and operate a ticket parking scheme.

This declaration is a Disallowable Instrument, and must be presented to the Legislative Assembly within 6 sitting days after its notification in pursuance of Section 64 of the *Legislation Act 2001*.
