Road Transport (General) (Vehicle Registration and Related Fees) Determination 2007 (No 2)

Disallowable instrument DI2007–320

made under the

Road Transport (General) Act 1999, Section 96 (Determination of fees, charges and other amounts)

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

Section 96 of the *Road Transport (General) Act 1999* authorises the Minister to determine fees, charges and other amounts payable under the ACT road transport legislation.

This instrument has the effect of determining fees, payable in advance, for vehicle registration and related transactions carried out under the road transport legislation.

The Road Transport (General) (Vehicle Registration and Related Fees) Determination 2007 (No.2) provides for an increase in the fee for the inspection of a vehicle by government authorised examiners for motor vehicles not exceeding 4.5 tonnes GVM from \$38.40 to \$50.00 including GST.

No other fees are affected by this determination.

This determination is a disallowable instrument and must be presented to the Legislative Assembly within 6 sitting days after its notification pursuant to section 64 of the *Legislation Act 2001*.
