Road Transport (Public Passenger Services) Regular Route Services Maximum Fares Determination 2008 (No 1)

Disallowable Instrument DI2008 -142

made under the

Road Transport (Public Passenger Services) Act 2001, s 23 (Regular route services – power to determine maximum fares)

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

Under section 23 of the *Road Transport (Public Passenger Services) Act 2001* the Minister may determine maximum fares, and ways of calculating maximum fares, payable by passengers on regular route services.

This instrument revokes Disallowable Instrument DI2007-307 (Road Transport (Public Passenger Services) Maximum Fares Determination 2007 (No 1)). This instrument is substantially the same as the former instrument, but includes a provision for free travel on ACTION regular route services for persons who hold an ACTION Gold Card. To be eligible for an ACTION Gold Card, a person must be an ACT resident and have attained the age of 75 years.

The maximum fare amounts and other eligibility conditions for concessional travel remain unchanged.

This instrument commences 1 July 2008.
