

Road Transport (Safety and Traffic Management) Parking Authority Declaration 2009 (No 2)

Disallowable instrument DI2009–123

made under the

Road Transport (Safety and Traffic Management) Regulation 2000, section 75A (2)
(Parking Authority)

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

Section 75A (2) of the *Road Transport (Safety and Traffic Management) Regulation 2000* permits the Road Transport Authority (RTA) to declare a person to be a parking authority which may establish and operate a ticket parking scheme for any length of road or area under its control in accordance with the *Road Transport (Safety and Traffic Management) Guidelines 2002*.

On 18 July 2008, Mirvac Parking Pty Limited was declared as a parking authority to establish and operate a ticket parking scheme within the boundary of Blocks 19 and 20, Section 63, City (DI2008-190).

On 1 July 2009, Wilson Parking Australia 1992 Pty Ltd will be taking over the responsibility from Mirvac Parking Pty Limited for the operation of this ticket parking area. Wilson Parking Australia 1992 Pty Ltd has applied to the RTA to be declared as a parking authority to continue operating the ticket parking scheme within Blocks 19 and 20, Section 63, City.

The new disallowable instrument gives effect to the declaration by the RTA of Wilson Parking Australia 1992 Pty Ltd as a parking authority for the car park area within Blocks 19 and 20, Section 63, City to establish and operate a ticket parking scheme.

This disallowable instrument also repeals DI2008-190 (which is about Mirvac Parking Pty Ltd) dated 17 July 2008.
