This Determination of Fees revokes and replaces the Determination of Fees DI2009-56, dated 20 April 2009.

The Determination comes into effect on 1 July 2009 and reproduces Determination DI2009-56 except for:

- Items on Attachment A, which have increased by the Wage Price Index of 3.5% (subject to rounding);
- Items on Attachment B, which have increased by the National Consumer Price Index of 2.5% (subject to rounding);
- Items on Attachment C, which are new, replacement or deleted fees;
- Items on Attachment D, which have increased by other factors as outlined in the attachment;
- Item W (Emergency Department Treatment), which was moved from Item H.3; and
- the date of effect.
