Construction Occupations Licensing (Fees) Determination 2009 (No 1)

Construction Occupations (Licensing) Act 2004, s 127 (Determination of fees)

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The *Construction Occupations (Licensing) Act 2004* is an Act to regulate construction occupations, and for other purposes.

Section 127 of the Act provides the Minister with the power to determine fees.

The purpose of this determination is to revoke Disallowable Instrument DI 2008 - 162 that set fees for the 2008-09 financial year and to determine fees for the 2009-10 financial year.

The fees determined for the 2009-10 financial year represent the 2008-09 financial year fees increased in accordance with Treasury's inflation factor of 3.5%. Rounding to the dollar has occurred in relation to the increases.

New fees have been set in relation to requests for:

- amendments to a construction occupation licence and
- the appointment, revocation or resignation of nominees.

The fees take effect on 1 July 2009.

The determination under section 127 of the Act is a disallowable instrument.
