CONSUMER AND TRADER TRIBUNAL BILL 2003**Amendments to be moved by the Attorney-General****Amendment 1**

Amendment 1 amends clause 33 of the Bill by inserting a reference to provisions of the *Legislation Act 2001* which allows summonsed witnesses to claim client legal privilege and the privilege against self-incrimination. This amendment is the result of comments from the Scrutiny of Bill's Committee.

Amendment 2

Amendment 2 amends clause 46 of the Bill by limiting the amount of money that the Tribunal can order a person, who is the subject of disciplinary proceedings, to pay. The amendment limits the amount to \$1,000 for an individual and \$5,000 for a company. This amendment is the result of comments from the Scrutiny of Bill's Committee. This amendment also brings this power into line with the powers of the Agents Board, the Liquor Board and the Registrar of Motor Vehicle Dealers.
