Planning and Development (Fees) Determination 2009 (No 3)

Planning and Development Act 2007, s 424 (Determination of fees)

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The *Planning and Development Act 2007* is an Act about planning and development in the ACT.

Section 424 of the Act provides the Minister with the power to determine fees.

The purpose of this determination is to revoke Disallowable Instruments DI 2009-141 that set fees for 2009-10 financial year as fees have been clarified, deleted and additional fees included for the 2009-10 financial year.

The changes include:

- new fees for additional signage relating to minor and major public notification;
- clarification of the impact track Estate Development Plan fees; and
- the deletion of fees relating to initial network plans which are now incorporated in development application fees.

The fees take effect on 1 August 2009.

The determination under section 424 of the Act is a disallowable instrument.
