EXPLANATORY STATEMENT No. 8 of 1980

<u>Subject</u>: Australian Capital Territory Administration and Probate (Amendment) Ordinance 1980

The Administration and Probate (Amendment) Ordinance 1980 repeals the provisions now existing in Part X and the Third Schedule of the Administration and Probate Ordinance 1929 for the payment of fees in connexion with matters to which that Ordinance relates, principally the granting of probate or letters of administration in deceased estates.

Those fees have been replaced by the Australian Capital Territory Supreme Court (Fees) Regulations which have been made under the Australian Capital Territory Supreme Court Act 1933. The regulations prescribe fees to be taken in respect of proceedings in the Supreme Court of the Australian Capital Territory.
