

# Road Transport (General) Refund and Dishonoured Payments Fees Determination 2010

Disallowable instrument DI2010–76

made under the

*Road Transport (General) Act 1999, section 96 (Determination of fees, charges and other amounts)*

## EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

---

Section 96 of the *Road Transport (General) Act 1999* allows the Minister to determine fees, charges and other amounts payable under the ACT road transport legislation.

This disallowable instrument has the effect of determining fees for transactions relating to refunds and the handling of dishonoured cheques. The fees in the determination have been increased by the Wage Price Index of 3.5%, rounded down to the nearest ten cents.

This determination includes for the first time a fee for a dishonoured credit card payment, in addition to the fee for a dishonoured cheque payment.

This determination is a disallowable instrument and must be presented to the Legislative Assembly within 6 sitting days after its notification pursuant to section 64 of the *Legislation Act 2001*.
