

Road Transport (General) Fees for Publications Determination 2010

Disallowable instrument DI2010–78

made under the

Road Transport (General) Act 1999, section 96 (Determination of fees, charges and other amounts)

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

Section 96 of the *Road Transport (General) Act 1999* (the Act) allows the Minister to determine fees, charges and other amounts. Section 96 (2) (b) provides that a fee, charge or other amount may be determined in relation to any other service or facility provided for road users or particular road users, including, for example, a facility for, or to improve, road safety or transport efficiency.

This determination sets the fees for various kinds of road transport publications. These publications are made available by the road transport authority on request.

The fees for the 2010-2011 financial year have been increased by the Wage Price Index of 3.5%, rounded down to the nearest ten cents.

This determination is a disallowable instrument and must be presented to the Legislative Assembly within 6 sitting days after its notification pursuant to section 64 of the *Legislation Act 2001*.
