Water Resources (Fees) Determination 2010 (No 1)

Water Resources Act 2007, section 107 – Determination of fees

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

Section 107 of the *Water Resources Act 2007* (the Act) permits the Minister to determine fees for the purposes of the Act.

This determination revokes the previous fee determination (DI2009–109) that set fees for the 2009-2010 financial year, and establishes fees from 1 July 2010.

The determination:

- increases most fees in accordance with the Wage Price Index estimate for 2010-11 of 3.50%, consistent with the Government's announcement, made as part of the 2006-07 ACT Budget, on the indexing of government fees and charges; and
- inserts two new application fees for the acquisition and disposal of transferrable water access entitlements either permanently or for a period of time. These new fees are required as a result of the introduction of interstate water trading.

The increased fees are rounded down to the nearest 5 cents.

This determination takes effect from 1 July 2010.
