Sports Bookmaking Events Determination 2003 (No. 1)

Disallowable instrument DI2003—34

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The *Race and Sports Bookmakers Act 2001* (the Act) governs the activities of sports bookmakers in the Australian Capital Territory.

Part 3 of the Act provides for the conduct and control of sports bookmaking. In particular, subsection 20(1) of the Act provides that the Commission may, in writing, determine a sporting or other event to be a sports bookmaking event for the purpose of the Act.

This determination revokes determinations No. 261 of 2001 and DI2002-173. In particular, it merges these two former determinations and introduces North American thoroughbred, harness, greyhound and quarter horse racing events as determined sports bookmaking events.
