EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The reprinting of the Ordinances of the Australian Capital Territory in pamphlet form is in the course of preparation.

In the case of Ordinances that have ceased to operate or are no longer necessary, it is desirable to repeal them in order that they do not have to be reprinted. Before other Ordinances are reprinted, it is desirable to effect amendments to remove unnecessary matter, correct errors and make other necessary or appropriate changes of a formal nature.

The purpose of the proposed Ordinances Revision Ordinance 1978 is to achieve those objects.

Section 2 provides for the repeal of the Ordinances specified in Schedule 1. The Ordinances so specified are Ordinances that need not remain on the Statute book.

Section 3 provides for the amendment of the Ordinances specified in Schedule 2. The amendments contained in the Schedule are of a formal nature.

As this Ordinance is formal in nature and should be made expeditiously to enable reprinting of the Ordinances to proceed, it has not been submitted to the Legislative Assembly.
