Medicines, Poisons and Therapeutic Goods (Fees) Determination 2010 (No 1)

Disallowable Instrument DI2010-277

made under the

Medicines, Poisons and Therapeutic Goods Act 2008, s 197 (Determination of fees)

This Determination of Fees revokes and replaces the Determination of Fees DI2009-59, dated 14 February 2009.

The Determination comes into effect on 1 January 2011 and increases the fees by the Wage Price Indexation rate of 3.5% (rounded to the nearest \$1), as set out below:
