DISALLOWABLE INSTRUMENT DI 2003 - 46

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The Road Transport (Offences) Regulations 2001, under subregulation 21(1)(e), empower the Minister to declare a period to be a holiday period. The notice, by virtue of subregulation 21(4), is a disallowable instrument for the purposes of section 9 of the *Legislation Act 2001*.

This instrument specifies the period from the first moment of Thursday 17 April 2003 to the last moment of Sunday 27 April 2003 (inclusive) to be a holiday period. Accordingly, for this period, additional demerit points, as specified in subregulation 20(2), will apply.

The declaration will link the Easter holiday period for April 2003 with the Anzac Day holiday period for April 2003, which is expected to be consistent with the double demerit period in NSW.
