## **EXPLANATORY STATEMENT**

The Construction Occupations (Licensing) Act 2004 regulates construction occupations in the ACT.

Section 127 of the *Construction Occupations (Licensing) Act 2004* provides the Minister with the power to determine certain regulatory fees.

On 19 August 2010, the Legislative Assembly passed the *Construction Occupations Legislation Amendment Act 2010 (No. 2)* (the Act). The Act was notified on 1 September 2010 and has a default commencement date of 1 March 2011. The Act creates the new construction occupation of *building assessor* to assist with the effective regulation of this occupation.

The purpose of this determination is to set fees for the new classes of occupational licence: Class A building assessor-energy efficiency; and Class B building assessor-energy efficiency.

Section 81 of *The Legislation Act 2001* 'Exercise of powers between notification and commencement' has application in the making of this determination.

The determination under section 127 of the *Construction Occupations (Licensing) Act 2004* is a disallowable instrument.
