REAL PROPERTY ORDINANCE 1967

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

No. 46 of 1967

The purpose of the Real Property Ordinance 1967 is to amend the Real Property Ordinance 1925-1963.

One amendment is made as a consequence of the making of the Surveyors Ordinance 1967; it omits a provision for the licensing of surveyors and requires plans to be made by surveyors registered under Surveyors Ordinance 1967. Transitional provisions are included to cover surveys carried out or being carried out under the present provisions.

The designation of the Commonwealth Surveyor-General is also brought up to date and the table of fees set out in the Eighteenth Schedule is converted to decimal currency.
