# Heritage (Council Deputy Chairperson) Appointment 2011 (No 1)

**Disallowable instrument DI2011–102**

made under the

**Heritage Act 2004**

## EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

---

This instrument is made under Section 17 of the *Heritage Act 2004*.

Part 3, Section 16 of the *Heritage Act 2004* establishes the ACT Heritage Council. Members of Council, including the Chairperson and Deputy Chairperson, are appointed by the Minister under section 17.

This instrument appoints Dr Dianne Firth (member of ACT Heritage Council) as Deputy Chairperson for a period of one year.

The appointee is not an ACT Public Servant and this instrument makes an appointment to which the *Legislation Act 2001*, Division 19.3.3 applies. Accordingly, under the *Legislation Act 2001*, s.229 the instrument is a disallowable instrument.

This appointment has been approved by the Minister for Arts and Heritage, and the Standing Committee on Planning, Public Works and Territory and Municipal Services has been consulted in accordance with section 228 (consultation with appropriate Assembly committee) of the *Legislation Act 2001*.
