

## Explanatory Statement

# Medicines, Poisons and Therapeutic Goods (Fees) Determination 2011 (No 1)

### Disallowable Instrument DI2011-326

made under the

**Medicines, Poisons and Therapeutic Goods Act 2008, s 197 (Determination of fees)**

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This Determination of Fees revokes and replaces the Determination of Fees DI2010-277, dated 28 October 2010.

The Determination comes into effect on 1 February 2012 and increases the fees by the Wage Price Indexation rate of 3.5% (rounded to the nearest \$1), as set out below:
